Competition rules

Competition will be held according to the FAI CIVL Sporting Code and the Austrian Competition rules.

Participation requirements

Valid national paragliding license and FAI Sporting license

Certified glider with valid liability insurance, helmet, rescue and back protector

Number of participants is limited to 80 pilots! Registration for the competition is run on a 'first paid, first confirmed' basis until the competition is booked out.

Liability

All pilots fly under their own responsibility.

It is each pilot's responsibility to take all necessary actions to maintain their own safety during the competition, and to ensure that they do not act in any way that might endanger any other pilots during the competition. It is a condition of entry to the event for all pilots to accept without restriction to hold the Organisers / owners of take-off and landings blameless, and waive all claims to compensation. The participation at the competition, transfers, retrieve and general program is at your own risk!

Cancellation of competition

Friday June 19th at 12 am it will be definitely decided if the competition will be hold or cancelled due to weather restrictions. This will be published at the website <u>www.paragleiterclub-steiermark.at</u> and the Facebook-page (<u>https://www.facebook.com/events/1578139999102966/</u>) of the competition.

Registration

Online registration at www.paragleitclub-steiermark.at. The template will be e-mailed after your application. This needs to be signed and shown at the competition office (Friday June 19th 8 pm – 9 pm and Saturday June 20th 7 am – 9.30 am competition office at well welt lake cafee house "Seekaffee" Kumberg). The entry fee needs to be paid at the competition office.

Entry fee

The entry fee needs to be paid in cash during registration at the competition office. Overall, sport class and Styrian Championship € 52,- | Newcomer class and PGC members € 30,-

Service

The entry feed does include: ONF competition fee, local maps, transfer to take off, coordination for retrieve, compilation and generation of scores.

Competition classes

All competition classes according to definition of the Austrian paragliding league Overall class (ist gleichzeitig die Gesamtwertung Schöckl Pokal 2015) | Sport class | Newcomer class | Styrian Championship

Competition tasks

The competition is planned for 2 tasks. The tasks will be set by the race comitee based on the daily weather forecast directly before the start of the task. Participation to briefing is mandatory (english briefing /weather briefing on demand)

Documentation and Scoring

The use of GPS systems for documentation of the flights is mandatory. Compilation and scoring according to the rules of the austrian paragliding league. A fit for purpose Computer connecting cable needs to be provided by the participant. (most common cables are available)

Complaint and protest

Complaint in written form within 30 min. after display of unofficial results. Protest in written form within 30 min. after display of official results. Protest fee: € 50,- Protest fee to the ONF according to Austrian competition rules.

Prizes

Trophies and giveaways; cash prices depending on the number of participants. Medals for the participation in the Styrian championships (Styrian Champion overall | Styrian Champion Ladies; min nbr. of participants: 5)
